



FERRUM CRESCENT CODE OF CONDUCT

It is Company policy that Ferrum Crescent Limited (“Ferrum” or the “Company”) conducts its activities with honesty, integrity and high ethical standards. For Ferrum to conduct its activities with honesty, integrity and high ethical standards, it must have a board, management and employees and agents who are committed to such standards.

The purpose of this Code of Conduct is to provide guidelines as to what behaviour the Company expects of its directors and employees. It applies to all Ferrum directors and employees. For the purposes of this Code, the term “employees” will include contractors and consultants engaged by Ferrum.

These are the standards of behaviour required by Ferrum:

- **Honesty and Integrity**

People representing or working for Ferrum carry out their duties honestly and in a manner which is professional, fair and ethical.

- **Compliance with Applicable Laws**

As a minimum, Ferrum carries out its activities, and people representing or working for Ferrum carry out their activities, in compliance with all laws applicable to those activities (in whichever jurisdiction that applies).

- **Compliance with Contracts**

Ferrum honours its contractual commitments.

- **Business Expenses**

Travel, entertainment and other business expenses are incurred in a reasonable and financially responsible manner.

Ferrum Crescent Code of Conduct

○ **Confidential Information and Intellectual Property**

Ferrum's confidential technical, financial and commercial information is not divulged to others except to comply with the law or as required for the purpose of Ferrum's business. All employees who supply services to Ferrum must meet these standards. Furthermore, intellectual property created for Ferrum in the course of work for the Company, including by contractors, belongs to Ferrum. All contracts for the supply of services, where intellectual property may be created, must stipulate this ownership requirement.

○ **Gifts**

Gifts, personal services, discounts or other gratuities may not be given to or accepted from Ferrum's business associates or government officials.

○ **Insider Trading**

Ferrum's directors and employees must not engage in insider trading of Ferrum shares or shares of any other company.

○ **Conflicts of Interest**

Ferrum's directors and employees should avoid situations where their private or non-Ferrum interests conflict with the interests of Ferrum in what they are doing or deciding for Ferrum.

○ **Community Standards**

Ferrum aims to conduct its business in a way that reflects the applicable community standards. In order to achieve this, it has adopted policies which describe the principles which guide Ferrum's business in such areas as:-
